### Notes to Table 6.2

- A The heading 'Entity DBA' refers to the name the sporting services provider is doing business as
- B The heading 'Status' refers to the legal status of the sporting services provider. 'AIA' refers to an entity incorporated under the Associations Incorporation Act for the State concerned and where the host university is the sole member; 'CLG' refers to a company limited by guarantee and which is wholly owned by the host university; 'UD' refers to an unincorporated university department – that is, part of the body corporate of the host university; 'UIE' refers to an unincorporated entity which is a controlled entity of the host university and which is consolidated in the university accounts
- C The heading 'Deliver > than sport?' refers to question 2 of the sport survey which asks whether the organisation is responsible for delivery of sporting as well as other campus services
- D The heading 'Responsible for all sporting services?' refers to question 3 of the sport survey
- E The heading 'Multi campus coverage?' refers to question 4 of the sport survey
- F The heading 'Merger since Dec 2005?' refers to question 5 of the sport survey

- G The heading ‘Acquisitions since Dec 2005?’ refers to question 6 of the sport survey
- H The heading ‘Divestments since Dec 2005?’ refers to question 7 of the sport survey
- I CSU does not manage the gymnasium at the CSU Bathurst campus but other than that manages in its own right all sporting facilities and services at all domestic CSU campuses
- J Curtin Guild manages campus sport, inter-university sport and recreational services. Curtin University manages in its own right the fitness centre and the other sporting facilities (as distinct from services)
- K Edith Cowan University in its own right manages all sporting facilities and services at the four ECU campuses of Joondalup, Mt Lawley, Churchlands and Bunbury
- L Flinders University Housing provides some sporting services for the residential colleges but apart from that Flinders One is solely responsible for providing all sporting facilities and services and all other parts of the campus services mix at Flinders University
- M Griffith University in its own right manages all sporting facilities and services and all other parts of the campus services mix at the Griffith University Nathan, Mt Gravatt, Southbank and Logan campuses. The Griffith University Student Guild manages all sporting facilities and services and all other parts of the campus services mix at the Griffith University Gold Coast campus
- N With the introduction of VSU the La Trobe University Union merged with the La Trobe University Sports Association (**SARA**) and the La Trobe University Children’s Centre to form the Division of Student Services (a department within the University). During the course of that merger the Union and SARA ceased to exist as separate organisations whilst the Children’s Centre is still undergoing that process. There is a new advisory body known as the La Trobe University Student Guild which has been formed to provide student input to the delivery of campus services. La Trobe University in its own right, via the Division of Student Services, now manages all sporting facilities and services and all other parts of the campus services mix at the La Trobe University Bundoora, Shepparton and Mildura campuses. The Bendigo Student Association (**BSA**) manages all sporting facilities and services and all other parts of the campus services mix at the La Trobe University Bendigo campus.
- O With the introduction of VSU Monash University Sport, a department of the University, took over sporting services from MONSU and MONYX and with effect from 2 January 2007 became solely responsible for providing all sporting facilities and services at all six domestic Monash campuses. MONYX was a controlled entity of the University and jointly owned by the University and the students of Monash

## 6. Changes in Who Delivers Campus Services

- P RMIT Union, an unincorporated body, is a controlled entity of RMIT University. RMIT Union staff are employees of and subject to the direction of the University. The assets of RMIT Union appear on the consolidated balance sheet of the University. RMIT Union is solely responsible for providing all sporting facilities and services and various other parts of the campus services mix at all six domestic RMIT campuses.
- Q At Southern Cross University the development of the University's Office of Sport and Cultural Activities (**OSCA**) was prompted by the closure of various campus services previously delivered by the SCU Union (operator of the Campus Central business).
- R Melbourne University Sport services only the Parkville campus. Delivery of sporting services at the regional campuses of the University is via student organisations at those campuses or via the Land and Food Resources Faculty of the University.
- S With effect from 1 September 2007 The University of New South Wales managed Lifestyle Centre at the Kensington campus merged with the UNSW Sports Association to create the new University Department of Sport and Recreation.
